Colin H. Chisholm Park Use Policy

This is a small passive park situated in the central part of town. It has the following for the public's use: park benches and gazebo. The gazebo and benches are arranged in such a manner that the park can be used for small public concerts.

The general public is encouraged to use this area on an ad hoc informal basis.

Groups or individuals wishing to use this park on a more formalized basis must now meet the following criteria:

- 1) Written application must be filed one week prior to the event outlining the purpose of the event. Groups/individuals must meet the liability insurance requirements of the Town of Antigonish. Applications are available at the Recreation Office at 274 Main Street, Antigonish.
- 2) Only groups offering free performances or non profit organizations will be considered.
 - A) The performance must be completed by 9:30 p.m. and conform with the noise bylaw of the Town of Antigonish.
 - B) Should a non profit organization be using this park for fundraising, the fee for use shall be as outlined in the facility use charge. A damage deposit of \$100 must be attached to the application. This will be refunded, if after inspection of the park, it is found to be in a clean and tidy state.

It is to be understood that the area is a public park and that every effort will be made to ensure that the park will be clean prior to use. However the unexpected may occur and groups should be prepared to act accordingly prior to using the park. The park is to be left in a clean and tidy manner when finished.
