

Addendum #2

Date August 5th, 2021

1. Can the feasibility study be provided?

The feasibility study is posted on our website, as an additional addendum. It should be noted that some aspects of the project have been further refined since this was developed, and so bidders are advised that aspects of it may not be entirely accurate.

2. The information in the RFP does not mention intersection treatments. Are there any specific treatments or considerations at intersections that need to be included in the design.

It is our understanding that the intersection treatments would be determined by the consultants in the course of the design process; some general treatment options are outlined in the feasibility study but those may be adjusted as required given site conditions.

3. Is a signage plan required? We notice that the Class D cost estimate does not include signage.

General wayfinding signage will not be required as part of the project, but indications can be made in the design regarding where future signage can be placed. Regulatory signage must be included.

4. Is any new or supplemental lighting design required?

Supplemental lighting is not being considered as part of this project, but indications can be made for recommended locations of future installations.

5. Addendum #1 indicates that the consultants will be responsible for completing geotechnical investigations. Can you confirm the scope of the geotechnical investigations?

The scope of the geotechnical will primarily be focused on the establishment of the AT bridges.

6. Is there any as built information for underground services? Or is the surveyor required to pick up all underground services (sanitary and storm inverts)?

The Public Works Department would have information regarding underground services, and the consultants and/or surveyor can coordinate information sharing with Town staff on this aspect of the project once engaged.

7. Addendum #1 indicates that the consultants will be responsible for completing traffic impact studies to support change to the vehicle travel lanes. Does the Town have any recent traffic count data along these roadways?

The Town does not have traffic count information for the impacted roadways.

8. Does the Town intend to procure design-build prefabricated bridges? This will have a significant impact on the consultant fee associated with this RFP.

Yes, the Town is considering a pre-fabricated/pre-engineered pedestrian/active transportation bridges.

9. Can you confirm the permitting requirements?

There are no municipal permitting requirements, but coordination with our Public Works Department will be required for any tie-ins to storm sewer, etc., as required. Permits may be required from the Department of Environment for work completed in and around watercourses.

10. Can you confirm if there are any archeological requirements?

There are no archeological requirements that we are aware of at this time.
